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**Instructions to authors for the preparation of the paper:**

The Horizons 2023 conference publishes papers that have not been published anywhere before, nor submitted for publication. Any attempt at plagiarism or self-plagiarism is punished.

Papers are to be written in Microsoft Office Word – Times New Roman font (size 12pt for the main text and 10pt for footnotes and bibliography, with 1.5 spacing), double-sided alignment (justify/centered) and standard margins of 25 mm. The volume of manuscript should not exceed 8 pages.

**The paper should successively contain:** ORCID numbers of all authors, title of the paper, names of authors and institutions, summary (in Serbian or English) and keywords, text of the paper, conclusion and list of references.

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The parts of the paper are: **title page, abstract with keywords, text of the paper, acknowledgment (optional), literature, attachments.**

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**Paper title**

- a) The title should preferably be short, clear, informative and appropriate to the content, sub-headings should be avoided.
- b) The full names and surnames of the authors are written with marks in the order: \*, †, ‡, §, ||, ¶, \*\*, ††, ....
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***Abstract and keywords***

A structured abstract (150 words) can be found under the title, authors' and institutions' names. In short sentences in Serbian and English, the basic idea, goal, method of work and achieved results are presented (for scientific work: Introduction/Goal of the work, basic procedures - Methods (selection of subjects; methods of observation and analysis), main findings - Results (specific data and their statistical significance) and the main Conclusion). Below the abstract, "Keywords"

contains 3-10 keywords or short phrases that indicate the content of the article.

### **The text of the paper**

The text should contain the following chapters: **introduction, methods, results and discussion with conclusion, or the conclusion separately.**

**Introduction.** Briefly state the findings so far and the reasons for the research or observation. Cite only important data from the literature, not extensive considerations on the subject of the work, nor data or conclusions from the work being reported on. At the end of the introduction, state the **aim** of the work.

**Methods.** Clearly describe the choice of research methods or experimental methods (respondents, identify methods, apparatus, experimental procedure, state the statistical procedure).

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In the **discussion**, emphasize new and significant aspects of the research and the conclusions drawn. Connect the observations with other relevant studies, in principle from the last five years, and only exceptionally older ones. Connect the **conclusions** with the goals of the work.

The **literature** is cited in parentheses (Butler, 2020), and at the end in the bibliography with full data (APA standard). All data on cited literature must be correct. Citation of abstracts, secondary publications, oral communications, unpublished works, official and confidential documents is not accepted. At the end of the text, a list of only those bibliographic units cited in the text, in the language and script in which they were published, is attached, in alphabetical order.

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### **Accepted papers are classified into scientific and professional papers:**

**Scientific papers:** 1) original scientific article, 2) overview scientific article, 3) short or previous announcement, 4) scientific criticism, or polemic.
